What do I need to do to move my solar journey forward?

Now that your solar power system has been installed, the next step to making solar power even more rewarding is to accept AGL's Transitional Feed-in Tariff Offer.

> Accepting AGL's Transitional Feed-in Tariff Offer.

By accepting AGL's Transitional Feed-in Tariff Offer you can receive 33 cents for every kWh of electricity you feed back into the grid (the network of wires that delivers electricity from generators to homes and businesses around Australia).

> Will I need to have my meter changed?

Your Electricity Distributor (who is responsible for the electricity poles, wires and meters in your area) may need to change the type of meter at your supply address to connect your solar electricity generating facility to the distribution system. In some cases your previous retail tariff may not be available as a result of this change. To check if your retail tariff will be affected, call us on **131 245**.

What is a Meter Alteration Fee and why does it apply to me?

A Meter Alteration Fee, sometimes referred to as a Truck Appointment Fee or Bring Forward Service Fee, is charged by your Electricity Distributor and covers their cost for coming to your property and installing a new meter. This is a fee that AGL has no control over. AGL pass this fee on to you through your electricity bill.

The **Electricity Generation Feed-in Terms** exist as a separate document to this Offer, which you should have received a copy of. If you require an additional copy of the Feed-in Terms, please visit agl.com.au or call us to request a copy.

How to complete this form.

Section A – Account holder's details.

Enter the personal details of the account holder including first name, last name, postal address, customer type, ABN (if relevant), contact phone number, mobile phone number and email address. These must be the details of the AGL account holder only.

Section B – Supply address details (Victoria only).

Enter the details of the supply address at which your Solar photovoltaic (PV) system is installed including lot/unit/house number, street name, suburb, postcode and meter identification number (also referred to as NMI).

Section C – AGL Transitional Feed-in Tariff Offer schedule.

Read the schedule for AGL's Transitional Feed-in Tariff Offer including eligibility for the Offer and reference to annual credit balance payment, and enter the details about your Solar PV system where appropriate. If you're unsure of your system's details, check the documentation provided to you at the time of installation or contact your installer.

Section D – Acknowledgement and acceptance.

To confirm you acknowledge and accept the Transitional Feed-in Tariff Offer print your full name, then sign and date in the appropriate areas.
