

Proposed Newcastle Gas Storage Facility at Tomago with connecting infrastructure to Hexham

Dear neighbour

Re: Investigative works and vegetation clearance at AGL's proposed gas storage facility site.

During the week commencing 23 May 2011, AGL is planning to conduct some geotechnical investigations on its proposed gas storage facility site just east of the Tomago Aluminium northern access road. (Refer to location map on the reverse of this letter).

To undertake these tests we need to clear some of the vegetation. We have been working closely with the Port Stephens Council seeking a development application to complete these preliminary works in the least invasive way.

These investigative works are part of the condition study for the underground pipeline and the proposed Newcastle Gas Storage Facility at this site.

The work is expected to take about two weeks to complete.

While we do not expect the work to adversely impact on local residents or businesses, AGL (and its contractors, Coffey Geotechnical and WorleyParsons) will ensure all safety precautions and environmental impacts such as dust and noise, are managed in accordance with the various regulatory requirements.

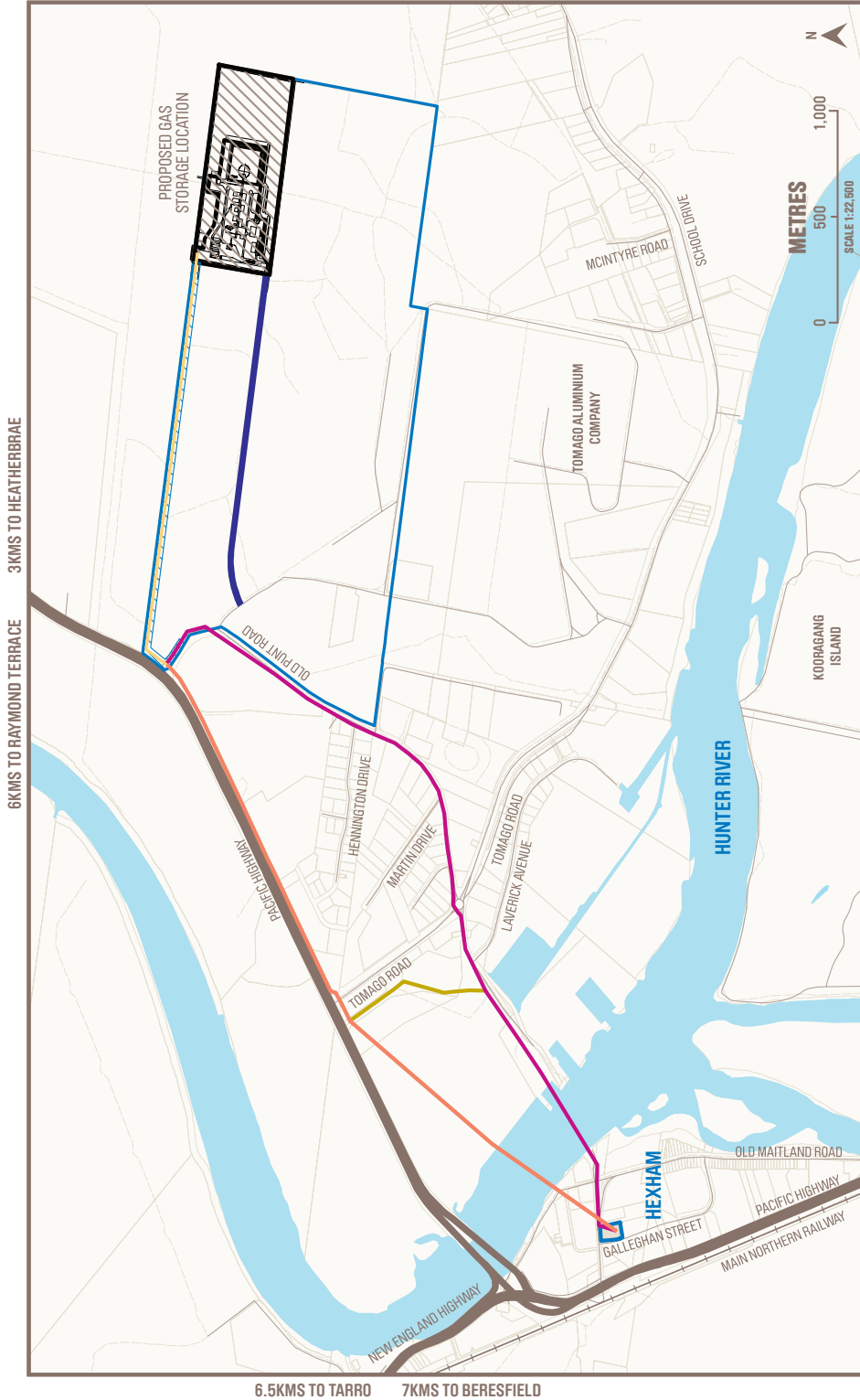
