RESIDENTIAL TARIFFS	THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW
Tariff 11 - Domestic	Peak rate applies at all times.
* Tariff 31 - Off peak Night Rate (Super Economy)	Tariff 31 night rate is applicable to customers who have storage water heaters and permanently connected heat banks. It can also be used to boost a solar hot water heater. Electricity supply is made available for a minimum of eight hours per day at times determined by your Distributor. Minimum charges apply to cover the cost of maintaining supply when there is little or no consumption.
^ Tariff 33 - Off peak Controlled Supply	Tariff 33 controlled supply is applicable to customers who have storage water heating such as electric storage water heaters, solar-electric water heaters and heat pump water heaters. Electricity supply is made available for a minimum of 18 hours per day at times determined by your Distributor. Minimum charges apply to cover the cost of maintaining supply when there is little or no consumption.
# Tariff 37 - Off peak Controlled Supply	Applicable to customers who have separately metered consumption, for example: storage water heaters or thermal storage space heaters. Peak charges apply 4.30pm to 10.30pm. Off peak all other times. Minimum charges apply to cover the cost of maintaining supply when there is little or no consumption.

SMALL BUSINESS TARIFFS	THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW
Tariff 20 - General Supply	Peak rate applies at all times.
Tariff 22 - General Supply - Time of Use	Peak charges apply 7am to 9pm, Monday to Friday. Off peak all other times.
* Tariff 31 - Off peak Night Rate (Super Economy)	Tariff 31 night rate is applicable to customers who have storage water heaters and permanently connected heat banks. It can also be used to boost a solar hot water heater. Electricity supply is made available for a minimum of eight hours per day at times determined by your Distributor. Minimum charges apply to cover the cost of maintaining supply when there is little or no consumption.
^ Tariff 33 - Off peak Controlled Supply	Tariff 33 controlled supply is applicable to customers who have storage water heating such as electric storage water heaters, solar-electric water heaters and heat pump water heaters. Electricity supply is made available for a minimum of 18 hours per day at times determined by your Distributor. Minimum charges apply to cover the cost of maintaining supply when there is little or no consumption.
# Tariff 37 - Off peak Controlled Supply	Applicable to customers who have separately metered consumption, for example: storage water heaters or thermal storage space heaters. Peak charges apply 4.30pm to 10.30pm. Off peak all other times. Minimum charges apply to cover the cost of maintaining supply when there is little or no consumption.
