## AGL Advantage® 5 Energy Plan

South Australia, residential customers, gas or electricity

This price fact sheet contains information relating to an AGL Advantage® 5 Energy Plan for gas or electricity as relevant, including AGL Green Choice™ options for electricity. These energy plans may not be available to all customers. Eligibility requirements are outlined at the end of this document.

The estimated annual costs set out in this price fact sheet are indicative only. Calculations assume demand for gas or electricity is constant during a full year. Your costs may be different from the estimated annual costs depending on:

- > your consumption of gas or electricity,
- > the pattern of your gas or electricity consumption over a full year,
- > your usage of off-peak electricity (where applicable), and
- > variations in the rates for gas or electricity charged by AGL over the term of the energy plan.

AGL Advantage® 5 Energy Plans are 24-month fixed-term contracts. AGL may vary the gas or electricity rates listed below with prior written notice.

When you add one of AGL's Green Choice™ options to your AGL Advantage® 5 electricity plan, AGL will source electricity equal to the selected percentage (10% for Green Spirit, 20% for Green Living, or 100% for AGL Green Energy®) of your electricity consumption from renewable energy sources that are approved under the National GreenPower Accreditation Program.
