Situation clarified with Mr Halfpenny.</p> <p>Staff informed of correct locking process on multi-lock gates. Information tag placed on gate.</p>	
<b>6.0</b>	<b>Project Operations Review</b>		
10-6.1	<p>Sydney Gas continues to achieve expected gas production through the Ray Beddoe Treatment Plant.</p> <p>The Rosalind Park Gas Plant is progressively increasing in capacity as more wells come on line.</p> <p>Production will continue to ramp up as additional wells are drilled and brought into the network. Additional areas of Sugarloaf, Razorback, El Bethel, Mt Gilead and Springfarm were discussed as future production areas.</p> <p>Approval received from the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Natural Resources to construct the gathering lines at Glenlee and EMAI.</p> <p>Johndillo Office / Workshop site under rehabilitation.</p> <p>FK discussed the new planning proposals which are the subject of a Bill to amend the <i>Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979</i> and the effects these would have on the approval process.</p> <p>The status of the Wyong Gas Project was discussed in response to queries from the committee. As some of the Committee members have been contacted by Wyong Committee members, it might be beneficial if the two committees met to discuss and assist with the Sydney Gas Wyong Project.</p> <p>The Committee was concerned that there was a lot of misinformation regarding the water issue and it was important for the Central Coast community to be adequately and properly informed.</p> <p>A briefing was given as to the drilling and fracing process and how Sydney Gas activities do not impact upon the water table.</p>
