Land & Approvals – Recent Developments

Policy

- › NSW Mining SEPP – Now in force. 2km buffer zone from all existing residential areas.
 - › DOPI exhibited maps across NSW showing:
 - CSG exclusion zones to future residential areas.
 - Locations of Strategic Agricultural Land
 - Critical Industry Clusters
 - › Exhibition finished 8th Nov.
- › Mining and Petroleum Gateway Panel will now conduct an independent upfront assessment of new State Significant applications.
- › Any CSG applications where it is determined that the project is likely to have a significant impact on water resources, will be referred to the Independent Expert Scientific Committee.

Health, Safety and Environment

- › 2012-13 Annual Environmental Performance Report now available from Camden Gas Project website.
- › Environmental Health Impact Assessment for the Northern Expansion project now available from Camden Gas Project website.
- › 2010-2012 Independent Environmental Audit corrective actions continue to be completed. The next update will be uploaded to the project website in December.
- › Inspections of production wells by EPA officer continue.
- › Site visit by the Office of CSG on 20 November to inspect areas rehabilitated during the previous financial year.

Field operations

- › No CSG Drilling since September 2012.
- › Well workovers undertaken in Menangle Park and Mt Taurus fields.
- › Next well workovers in Menangle Park field.

- › Water monitoring bores to be drilled at Glenlee/ Menangle Park in January 2014.
 - » Replace the previously proposed water monitoring bores at Currans Hill
 - » Notifications will be sent prior to works commencing
 - » 3 water monitoring bores to be drilled over 3 weeks (weather permitting) to depths of approx 100m, 150m, and 300m
 - » Results will be included in quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Reports

 - » Next quarterly monitoring scheduled for December

 - » September quarter monitoring results compliant
