Land & Approvals

- > The Camden North Expansion Project remains suspended.
- > The recent amendments to the Mining SEPP clarify that minor modifications can be made to approvals within the CSG exclusion zone.
- > In the next couple of months, AGL will likely apply to modify its Camden Project consents/approvals to make administrative changes for consistency (as per independent audit recommendations).

Rosalind Park Gas Plant

- > Compressor 1 Engine overhaul
 - » Compressor engine removed off site on 25 July for engine overhaul
 - » Expected to be reinstalled in October for commissioning in November

- > Noise monitoring
 - » June 2014 quarterly monitoring results compliant

- > Air emissions monitoring
 - » August monthly monitoring results compliant
 - » Awaiting results of September quarterly monitoring results
