AGL reaching new horizons with Dairy Connect.

AGL and Dairy Connect NSW have been working together to identify economic development opportunities for local dairy farmers in the Gloucester region. This includes exploring the potential for a powdered milk facility (using locally generated gas) to meet the growing Chinese market.

The input of local dairy farmers has been crucial and following recent workshops, some key actions are underway. Dairy Connect will soon be going to China to meet prospective investors, then will finalise a business plan and present key milestones to local farmers in the coming months.

Dairy Connect CEO, Mike Logan, believes the powdered milk facility shows great promise.
