

AGL Gloucester Gas Project community update.

Second round of funding for community groups opens soon.

Last year AGL announced the creation of our Local Community Investment Program to provide funding to local groups working to make a positive contribution to the Gloucester community.

The first round of funding provided grants to groups including the Rotary Club of Gloucester to establish a new fitness station as part of the Gloucester Fitness Trail, a contribution to the Gloucester RSL Sub-Branch towards their Centenary of ANZAC 2015 event, the Country Women's Association (Gloucester), and support for the University of Newcastle's Science and Engineering Challenges in our region. Other groups receiving funding include the Gloucester District Archers, who received a grant to pay for equipment and coaching for their Thursday night indoor archery sessions, where members of the local community who have never tried archery before are encouraged to have a go.

AGL is opening a second round of funding for local community groups and organisations February 1.
