Rosalind Gas Park Gas Plant ceased production last week (28 August 2023). The Rosalind Park site office will be moved into the Camden town centre in late 2023. The EPA has issued a draft licence variation that is an amended licence with significantly less environmental conditions, which reflects the reduced environmental risk. Quarterly noise monitoring continued until August 2023; no complaints or exceedances were received. Air emissions have been completed. There were some NOx exceedances late 2022 and early 2023 that were reported to the EPA. Six-monthly ground water monitoring on gas wells has been completed. Annual leak detection was brought forward this year to July due to the expected shut down later in 2023. Nine gas leaks were detected and were repaired within the allowable timeframe. Question DH: What happens in the long term after AGL has received

formal approval from the State Government for well decommissioning and lease relinquishment? How will the potential for gas leaking be

monitored once AGL has fulfilled its responsibility?

Answer AC: AGL fully decommissions each gas well in compliance with statutory conditions and to the EPA's satisfaction, at which time the EPA will provide final sign off, ensuring that is no potential for future gas leaks.  Question MC: Landowner and proposed future use of the gas plant site: environmental restoration plan – will there be regular updates?  Answer AC: Once agreement with the landowner regarding what will occur, the document will be available on the website. Once the works have begun, AGL are happy to provide an update to council and CCC members.  The Camden Gas Plant Legacy Funding finalised, successful recipients notified, and three of the five recipients have received their funding so far.	AGL to provide councils and members with updates on the environmental restoration plan as it is agreed and implemented	As information is available and dates are known
