





Coopers Gap Community Consultative Committee reminder for nominations

As part of the community engagement process for the proposed Coopers Gap Wind Farm Project, AGL is establishing a Coopers Gap Community Consultative Committee (CGCCC) and would like to extend an invitation to members of the community to register their interest in participating.

The aim of the CGCCC is to help strengthen the community engagement process so that any arising community issues can be appropriately addressed.

The CGCCC is a voluntary committee which will include various stakeholder and community representatives who have an interest or connection to the project.

AGL acknowledges there are community concerns regarding the development of the Coopers Gap Wind Farm, and of our past consultation activities. We hope that establishing a local consultative group will improve the dialogue and provide the community with:

 An opportunity to regularly engage with key community representatives and stakeholders, so AGL can be familiar with and can respond to community issues or concerns;

- An opportunity for the community to hear technical presentations by subject experts, at their request;
- An opportunity for the community to contribute to and monitor the planning and construction process; and,
- An opportunity to build trust between the community and the project team.

Initially we propose that the CGCCC meets monthly to discuss planning developments, as well as community issues and concerns regarding the project.

It will also provide an opportunity for the local community to work with the AGL project team.

AGL encourages the local community to join the committee, and be part of the discussion that will shape the planning and development of the proposed Coopers Gap Wind Farm.
