Introduction to Rhys Brown - Aecom

- » Rhys Brown is a senior acoustic engineer and noise specialist from engineering firm Aecom. AECOM has undertaken the study and Rhys is the lead author of the noise and vibration chapter and draft updated acoustic report being discussed today. The study has been prepared considering the impacts of the proposed project.
- » These impacts have been compared against guidance provided by various legislative bodies both in Australia and internationally who prepare documents to provide guidance on the preservation of health.
- » The Initial Assessment Report issued in March 2011 has 24 chapters of which the noise and vibration assessment is chapter 14. This report being presented today is revision of the noise and vibration assessment chapter and is a result of feedback from the submissions made by a broad range of stakeholders potentially impacted by the proposed Coopers Gap Wind Farm.
