## 2D Seismic Survey.

The 2D seismic survey that has been underway for several weeks across the Gloucester Gas Project Stage 1 field area is nearing completion. AGL wishes to thank landholders and community members for their co-operation, assistance and patience during this important operation.

Landholders and residents who have provided survey crews with access to their land in the seismic survey area are an integral part of the activity and its successful completion.

At times, the seismic work also moved onto the local road network, and while every attempt was made to minimise impact to local road users, we know some motorists were asked to stop. We thank drivers for their understanding while they were stopped at the worksites and then escorted through by our pilot vehicles.

Seismic data helps to build a regional geological understanding of the Gloucester Basin. Importantly, it helps our geologists

and geophysicists, who interpret this data, to confirm where the accessible coal seams are, and where they are not.

A more complete seismic map of the area contributes to a deeper understanding of the region's geology, enabling us to make more accurate decisions for the project.
