Soil improves at Tiedmans trial.

The latest six-monthly reporting on AGL's Tiedmans property shows soil structure improved during 2013. Some 37 ML of fresh water blended with produced water has been irrigated to-date.

The *Soil quality monitoring and management report* (Jan 2014) concludes that the soil structure in the main irrigation area has improved and shows no abnormal salinity or sodium levels.

The *Tiedman Irrigation Program – water compliance report* (Jan 2014) showed there was no change in stream, alluvial or shallow fractured rock groundwater levels or water quality that is attributable to irrigation program activities.
