

AGL Gloucester Gas Project community update.

What you need to know about the Waukivory Pilot.

AGL is currently waiting for approval to start work on flow testing four wells drilled in 2012 as part of the Waukivory Pilot Program. The flow testing will provide valuable information about the gas, water and geology of the Gloucester Basin. AGL is required to undertake this activity to comply with conditions of our State and Federal approvals for Stage 1 of the Gloucester Gas Project.

Should approval to flow test be granted, you can expect to see increased activity and movements of trucks, rigs, employees and contractors around the local area. We will install sound and light barriers and continue our regular water monitoring program. We will also examine air quality during the flow testing and compare measurements with baseline readings we took last year.
