

AGL Gloucester Gas Project community update.

AGL to monitor methane emissions around Gloucester.

AGL is committed to protecting the local environment where we operate. In response to community concerns about fugitive emissions of methane, we are working with Gloucester Shire Council to extend the air monitoring program by returning to check levels of methane from the Waukivory Pilot.

Last July, independent technicians took samples of the air quality from a 200 kilometre area around the Gloucester Basin using the Picarro, one of the world's best air quality measurement and analysis instruments, to establish a baseline level of methane.

AGL will return to check levels of methane – a naturally occurring, non-toxic gas – as part of the Waukivory Pilot, comparing them to the baseline results and sharing these results with the community.
