Respecting the decisions and views of landholders is fundamental to AGL's approach in developing our natural gas operations.

AGL has always respected the rights of landholders who choose not to work with us and community organisations who do not support our activities. We operate with courtesy and with respect and we would hope that those who work with us, or for us, would be treated the same way.

We also would hope that those who do not share our views would treat local landholders with the same courtesy and respect we extend to them.

The Agreed Principles of Land Access, signed by leading NSW agricultural organisations along with AGL and Santos, show we can work together regardless of individual positions held on gas development.
