### Notice of Class Action

5 June 2023

AGL Energy Limited (AGL) has been served with class action proceedings filed in the Federal Court of Australia.

The proceedings allege breaches of section 46 of the *Competition and Consumer Act 2010* (Cth) in relation to bidding in the South Australian Region of the National Electricity Market (**NEM**).

The NEM is a regulated wholesale electricity market operated by the Australian Energy Market Operator, with the Australian Energy Regulator undertaking compliance monitoring and enforcement.

AGL takes its compliance obligations seriously and intends to vigorously defend the proceedings.
