Project Update – AGL project update and stakeholder/community engagement update presented. A copy of the AGL presentation slides forms part of the minutes.

Project Overview

Some key points included:

- Joint First Nation workshop held in February 2025 cultural heritage the focus of discussions.
- Specifications confirmed maximum 49 wind turbines.
- Project maps presented with an explanation of micro siting provided. Adjustments being made to the location of some wind turbines and associated infrastructure (within the approval corridor) because of wedge tailed eagle nest buffer zone, Lomandra grassland, Fresnel zones of the Point-to-Point radio links and cultural heritage.
- Delivery schedule during construction: estimated to be one turbine per week; approx. ten trucks per turbine.
- Approvals update, including management plans and secondary approvals, permits and licences.
- Environmental update including Significant Environmental Benefit and Bird and Bat Utilisation Surveys.
- Overside overmass (OSOM) cargo draft plan expected August 2025; final in November 2025.

- Vestas discussions with contractors on work packages underway.
