



## Notification of approval decision

### Liddell Future Land Use and Enabling Works Project, Muswellbrook, NSW (EPBC 2022/09330)

This decision is made under section 130(1) and 133(1) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act). 
