

## How to get started on the **nbn**<sup>®</sup> network with AGL.

## First, check what's in the box.


Check you have each of these ready:

- ⊘ Modem
- ${\ensuremath{ \oslash}}$  White ethernet cable with red connectors
- ${\ensuremath{ \oslash}}$  White telephone cable

Once your **nbn** connection is confirmed, we'll send you an email letting you know it's time to complete the set-up of your modem.







## Now it's time to connect your modem.

<b>Step 1</b> Connect the modem power cord into the back of the modem and into your power point. Turn the power on at the power point.
<b>Step 2</b> Push the on/off button on the side of the modem.
<ul> <li>Step 3</li> <li>Connect one end of the white telephone cable to the grey DSL port on the back of your modem. Connect the other end to your phone socket.</li> <li>Note: <b>nbn</b> tends to activate one phone line within a property, so you may need to try several before you find the correct one. You'll know you've found the right one when the internet light is green, this can take 2-3 minutes.</li> </ul>
<b>Step 4</b> Connect your home phone to the port labelled Telephone 1 on the back of your modem. You'll only be able to connect your phone if your plan includes an <b>nbn</b> home phone service.
<b>Step 5</b> Time to get connected. To connect a WiFi device, you'll need the <b>WiFi Network</b> <b>Name</b> and the <b>WiFi Password</b> that is on the base of your

modem.
