



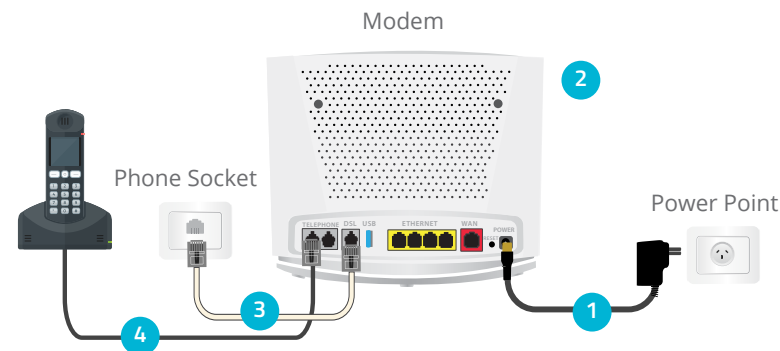
# How to get started on the **nbn**™ network with AGL.

## First, check what's in the box.

Check you have each of these ready:

- ✓ Modem
- ✓ Modem power cord
- ✓ White ethernet cable with red connectors
- ✓ White telephone cable

Once your **nbn** connection is confirmed, we'll send you an email letting you know it's time to complete the set-up of your modem.



## Now it's time to connect your modem.

	<p><b>Step 1</b> Connect the modem power cord into the back of the modem and into your power point. Turn the power on at the power point.</p>
	<p><b>Step 2</b> Push the on/off button on the side of the modem.</p>
	<p><b>Step 3</b> Connect one end of the white telephone cable to the grey DSL port on the back of your modem. Connect the other end to your phone socket.</p> <p>Note: <b>nbn</b> tends to activate one phone line within a property, so you may need to try several before you find the correct one. You'll know you've found the right one when the internet light is green, this can take 2-3 minutes.</p>
	<p><b>Step 4</b> Connect your home phone to the port labelled Telephone 1 on the back of your modem.</p> <p>You'll only be able to connect your phone if your plan includes an <b>nbn</b> home phone service.</p>
	<p><b>Step 5</b> Time to get connected.</p> <p>To connect a WiFi device, you'll need the <b>WiFi Network Name</b> and the <b>WiFi Password</b> that is on the base of your modem.</p>

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
