

How to get started on the **nbn**[®] network with AGL.

First, check what's in the box.


Check you have each of these ready:

- ⊘ Modem
- ${\ensuremath{ \oslash}}$ White ethernet cable with red connectors
- ${\ensuremath{ \oslash}}$ White telephone cable

Once your **nbn** connection is confirmed, we'll send you an email letting you know it's time to complete the set-up of your modem.







Now it's time to connect your modem.

Step 1 Connect the modem power cord into the back of the modem and into your power point. Turn the power on at the power point.
Step 2 Push the on/off button on the side of the modem.
 Step 3 Connect one end of the white telephone cable to the grey DSL port on the back of your modem. Connect the other end to your phone socket. Note: nbn tends to activate one phone line within a property, so you may need to try several before you find the correct one. You'll know you've found the right one when the internet light is green, this can take 2-3 minutes.
Step 4 Connect your home phone to the port labelled Telephone 1 on the back of your modem. You'll only be able to connect your phone if your plan includes an nbn home phone service.
Step 5 Time to get connected. To connect a WiFi device, you'll need the WiFi Network Name and the WiFi Password that is on the base of your

modem.
