



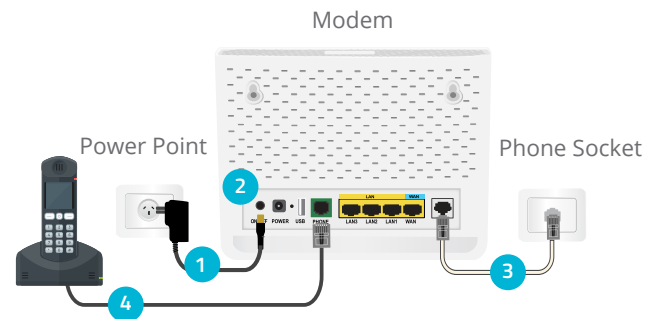
How to get started on the nbn™ network with AGL.

First, check what's in the box.

Check you have each of these ready:

- ✓ Modem
- ✓ Modem power cord
- ✓ Ethernet cable
- ✓ Telephone cable

Once your **nbn** connection is confirmed, we'll send you an email letting you know it's time to complete the set-up of your modem.



Now it's time to connect your modem.

	<p>Step 1</p> <p>Connect the modem power cord into the back of the modem and into your power point. Turn the power on at the power point.</p>
	<p>Step 2</p> <p>Push the on/off button on the back of the modem.</p>
	<p>Step 3</p> <p>Then connect one end of the telephone cable to the DSL port on the back of your modem. Connect the other end to your phone socket.</p> <p>Note: nbn tends to activate one phone line within a property, so you may need to try several before you find the correct one. You'll know you've found the right one when the internet light is green, this can take 2-3 minutes.</p>
	<p>Step 4</p> <p>Connect your home phone to the port labelled Phone on the back of your modem.</p> <p>You'll only be able to connect your phone if your plan includes an nbn home phone service.</p>
	<p>Step 5</p> <p>Time to get connected.</p> <p>To connect a WiFi device, you'll need the WiFi Network Name and the WiFi Password that is on the base of your modem.</p>

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
